IGCHE guidelines:-

Through intensive German language training as part of the curriculum, candidates are enabled to complete their 4th year in Germany. Before coming to Germany, students must pass the standard German university level test. As part of the German study program, the students will be attending German classes and do their internship in a German company, which is preferably combined with a bachelor thesis of a practical orientation. Fluency in German opens excellent opportunities with respect to employability at leading German companies with business interests in India, as well as Indian companies with business interests in Germany. During the first three years in India, summer schools are organized by IIK (Institute for International Communication, Düsseldorf) which the students can attend during semester breaks. These stays in Germany boost both motivation and language proficiency.









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
